

# Left Bank Writers Retreat in Paris Announces Student Discount

June Paris writing workshop finds Hemingway, and camaraderie, inspirational

*When:* June 11-16, 2017

*Where:* Paris, France

*What:* Now in its seventh year, the Left Bank Writers Retreat in Paris draws on the salon model that evoked creativity in author Ernest Hemingway and his friends.

*Cost:* \$500 off the \$1,999 tuition for students

*What does this cover:* Tuition covers all expenses from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m., breakfast, lunch, museum admissions, transportation in Paris, snacks, drinks, tickets for walking tours and boat cruise on the Seine.

*Itinerary:* The itinerary includes writing sessions, coaching and one-on-one time with the instructor for a maximum of eight writers, as well as lunch each day, admission to museums and area sights and a literary tour visiting many of the sites featured in the Woody Allen movie "Midnight in Paris" and Hemingway's famous "A Moveable Feast."

*Who:* Writers of all levels interested in poetry, nonfiction, fiction and drama. During the June retreat, participants experiment with many of the Left Bank writers' techniques.
